# **FROM THE COMMANDER**

To My Fellow Legionnaires,

Now that the first two months of the year are behind us, there is nothing lovelier than looking forward to springtime. Once the days get longer, the weather warms up, and colorful flowers start popping up, we are definitely ready to go outside and enjoy the glory of the season. The promise of Spring's arrival is enough to get us through the next two

Welcome New Members! I would like to take this opportunity to welcome the following new members to Post 217: Gregory Huston-USA, Global War on Terrorism, and Amy Stoots-USAF, Global War on Terrorism. Thank you for your service and for choosing Post 217. We look forward to having you as a part of our team!

**Membership:** According to our Membership Chair, Gary Bonnoront, we are currently at 92.56 % renewal; thank you to all who have submitted your renewal early to help us achieve this percentage. We still have 41 members from 2023 to renew for 2024 to reach our goal of 100% before the next renewal date begins July 1, 2024 for 2025 membership year.

\*\*\*\*NOTE\*\*\* The American Legion National dues for 2025 will increase by \$5 effective July 1, 2024. At the American Legion Department of Ohio Convention in July, their dues will also increase by \$5. Currently our dues are \$35, with \$18.50 submitted to National, \$9 to State,

and Post 217 \$7.50. With the increase July 1, National will be \$23.50, State \$14. If we do not increase our dues to offset National and State, we will have a loss of \$2.50 each member which results in a deficit of \$1,277.50 to our post. After considerable deliberation at the January Post 217 meeting, it was voted to raise our annual dues from \$35 to \$45 effective July 1, 2024 for the 2025 renewal period.

There is some good news. Last May, American Legion National Executive Committee approved offering a multiyear membership open to 2025 renewals (2025, 2026, 2027) if you renewed your 2024 membership prior to the rollout of this program on December 4, 2023. This means you can take advantage of a three-year membership starting with the 2025 membership year at the current rate of \$35. The multiyear membership sign-up is only available on the National American Legion website at legion.org/renew and legion.org/join. You must pay for all three years before July 1. 2024 which would be \$105. You cannot take advantage of this through the post level or mylegion.org. If you have not renewed your 2024 dues, you can still take advantage but would include the year 2024, 2025, and 2026.

### FROM THE TRUSTEES

Hello Veterans, Family, and Friends,

Hopefully, everyone is doing well, and we will see you soon at the Veterans Center (Canteen).

We are always in need of volunteers and so thankful to those who volunteer their time and talents, God Bless! With your help we will always keep the Veterans Center, Canteen, and Post 217 strong.

We still need to focus on painting the kitchen. Once this is completed, the inside of the building will have been painted within the past 18 months. How wonderful this will be to have this finished but we need volunteers to make this happen. Please consider volunteering a few hours to help us accomplish this project.

The following are projects we are currently working on 1) installing a light fixture to highlight the American Flag in the Canteen, 2) install an electrical plug in the outside building to support the bus, and 3) Level the dirt and plant grass seed in the Memorial Park. The Scouts are currently working on their Eagle Scout project of building benches for the 12-foot diameter concrete foundation located

behind the flags in the park and a base for the VFW War Medallions display.

We currently have 80 etched bricks to place once the weather cooperates. Roger Sidle has been out of state the past two months but will resume etching more bricks once he returns. We are still accepting orders for brick pavers; forms are available at the Veterans Center. It is never too late to submit your order.

We are researching composite benches to place on the six concrete areas leading to the Gazebo. They will be for sale from \$500 to \$700 each, depending on the lettering to be placed on them. We are looking at several options to place a sign at the entrance of the park identifying it as "Veterans Memorial Park." It could be made of metal, granite, wood, or brick. We are in the process of obtaining bids. Please let us know your suggestions for this sign, we would love to hear from you. We are hoping to receive additional donations for the sign to the park. Please know we are very grateful for all the donations and contributions received as we could not have accomplished this without your support. We want this Memorial Park to be a tribute to all veterans. their families, and friends as well as to all our sponsors and donors.

**Reminder:** It is so especially important to check on your veteran brothers and sisters. You can call, visit, or send a note. You will be surprised how it will make their day as well as yours!

We are thankful for all who are serving, have served, and serving our American Legion Post 217. May God Bless you and your family.
