Americanism and Government (A&G): Our hearts are saddened by the passing of Steve Peltier. Steve was a member of American Legion Post 217 for 52 years. He was

extremely instrumental in serving as our Treasurer for several years, being our post's Buckeye Boy State Chairman, and served as past-president of the Ohio Buckeye Boy State. He taught County Government to the delegates every year for 50 years during their eight-day experience. hands-on He was our Americanism and Government Chairman, overseeing the program administered to local high school students every fall. His knowledge, experience, and dedication to these programs will be sorely missed as will he. **Membership:** According to our Membership Chair, Gary Bonnoront, we are currently at 96.87% renewal. We still have 25 members from 2023 to renew for 2024 to reach our goal of 100% before the 2025 renewal date begins July 1, 2024.

\*\*\*\*IMPORTANT!!!!\*\*\* The American Legion National dues for 2025 will increase by \$5 effective July 1, 2024. At the American Legion Department of Ohio Convention in July, their dues will also increase by \$5. Currently our dues are \$35, with \$18.50 submitted to National, \$9 to State, and Post 217 \$7.50. With the increase July 1, National will be \$23.50, State \$14. If we do not increase our dues to offset National and State, we will have a loss of \$2.50 each member which results in a deficit of < Cont'd from Page 1 >

\$1,277.50 to our post. After considerable deliberation at the January Post 217 meeting, it was voted to raise our annual dues from \$35 to \$45 effective July 1, 2024 for the 2025 renewal period.

There is some good news. Last May, National American Legion Executive Committee approved offering a multiyear membership open to 2025 renewals (2025, 2026, 2027) if you renewed your 2024 membership prior to the rollout of this program on December 4, 2023. This means you can take advantage of a three-year membership starting with the 2025 membership year at the current rate of \$35. The multiyear membership sign-up is only available on the American Legion website National at legion.org/renew and legion.org/join. You must pay for all three years before July 1, 2024 which would total \$105. You cannot take advantage of this through the post level or mylegion.org. If you have not renewed your 2024 dues, you can still take advantage but would include the year 2024, 2025, and 2026.

We are very busy with projects in and outside the building. The kitchen painting is almost complete. Thankful for the volunteers who helped with this project. I would list all the volunteers, however, I may omit someone's name and it would upset me to omit a name. Please know how appreciative we are for your services. I would like to thank the Commander, Judy Johnson and Mila Hamilton for their much devoted work. So thankful for these young ladies in initiating the project.

Now that the weather is improving we are focusing on the Memorial Park project. The granite pavers to inscribe the names of our Memorial Park donors have arrived at the seller's location. Roger Sidle continues to engrave our veteran bricks and we have recently received 100 completed ones to place. Once he completes the next group of bricks, we will place them as soon as possible. Thank you for your patience, We still have brick applications available if you know of anyone who would like to purchase one to honor their veteran or even make a monetary donation. We greatly appreciate everyone's support of this worthy project! If you are interested in volunteering, we could use your help. The Eternal Flame's painting of the base and completion of the metal is still in progress.

With summer approaching, we are exploring ideas and obtaining bids to cover the back patio area. More information to follow.

The Emergency Management Agency (EMA) continues to research a generator for our building. We are exploring the idea of having a garage sale to clean out our storage rooms of items no longer needed. More to come later.
